

The goal of the partners was the further development of the "Bachelor Program in Spatial Planning for Iraq" at the University of Duhok, with the ultimate goal being development of this program as a joint degree program between TU Dortmund and the University of Duhok.

The "Spatial Planning" Joint B.Sc. program was established in 2012. As part of the joint program, professors from TU Dortmund are teaching and providing thesis supervision to students. The program has a shared Module Manuel, Joint Exam Regulations and the "Joint Certificate" in Bachelor of Science in Spatial Planning.



SUMMER SCHOOL IN GERMANY

The B.Sc. program consists of a summer school activity in Germany. Every year, students in their 6th academic semester (3rd stage) are accompanied by supervisor lecturers to attend the Summer Program studying "the Planning System in Germany" for 6 weeks in Germany, which holds 18 credit points. The program is part of the joint agreement between the two universities which enables the students to experience the German planning system as well as German higher education with TU Dortmund as exemplary institution of German higher learning.



The experience is a unique one for the students and an outstanding opportunity for cultural and educational exchange. The program begins in TU Dortmund where students attend lectures and excursions about the planning systems in Germany. The program also includes further visits to other German cities in the aim of exploring the State Departments, the History of the Development of German Cities, and Transportation Planning in Germany.
